Immaculate Conception Church can trace its roots back to 1857 when the first Catholic settlers arrived in and around Watertown. The town was first visited by a priest in 1859 and the parish was named Immaculate Conception in 1863 when the first church was built. The church's written records began in 1882. Descendants of the original founders of Immaculate Conception Church remain as parishioners to this day. From our humble beginnings, the church has continued to grow and share the beauty of our Catholic faith and the wonder of Gospel with our community.

As a result of consultation with Father Peter, our Parish Council, our Finance Committee, our Trustees and many outside contractors, Immaculate Conception will begin its *Grow in Grace, Planted in Purpose* Capital Campaign. As our community has grown over the years, so have our needs. This capital campaign will focus on honoring our Blessed Mother, our namesake, by transforming the church and its grounds, maintaining our current facilities, and making our church more accessible to every member of our community.

Why now?

The last major renovation of Immaculate Conception Church happened in the 1980s and there are still a number of projects that need to be done to preserve and maintain our facility and make it accessible to all parishoners. These projects will allow for greater participation in our sacramental ministry and enhance our liturgical experience by truly becoming a parish dedicated to the Immaculate Conception and our Blessed Mother. The campaign will span over two years and touch each and every aspect of our faith community ensuring our places to worship and gather are well-maintained for years to come.

Phase One



Phase One is the largest undertaking of the Capital Campaign, focusing on the interior of the church. It will include a newly designed sanctuary that focuses on lifting our eyes, minds and hearts to Heaven. As a parish dedicated to Mary our Blessed Mother, it will include many elements that tell the story of Mary from conception to being crowned with stars in the Book of Revelation. It will also include upgrades throughout the church including new carpet, refurbished pews and kneelers, redesigned confessionals and a new elevator.

Phase Two



Phase Two of our Capital Campaign will focus on updating the church grounds and exterior of the church and will include resealing and repairing the parking lot, updating the siding on the West and South side of the church and installing security cameras throughout our church campus.

Phase Three



Phase Three will focus on updating the Office/Religious Education building by making restrooms ADA accessible and compliant, replacing carpet and replacing the aging boiler.

CASH GIFTS

Donors can make cash payments using a check, credit or debit card, EFT or automatic bill pay.



PLEDGES

Donors may choose to make a more substantial gift payable over a period of time determined by the donor (up to two years). Donors who pledge may determine payment schedule to meet their own charitable or tax needs.



MATCHING GIFTS

If your company has a matching gift program, you may be able to enhance the impact of your gift by requesting a matching gift form from your employer and including it with your pledge form.



SECURITIES

Charitable gifts of stocks, bonds or mutual funds, which have been held for at least one year and have appreciated offer special tax advantages to the donor.



IRA TRANSFER

If you are over the age of 70-1/2 and have an IRA, you may be interested in donating directly from your retirement assets. Any gift of IRA assets must be transferred directly from your IRA brokerage account to the campaign.
